WORLD COMPUTER CONGRESS (WCC)

■ In the leadup to IFIP's formation, UNESCO organized the first International Conference on Information Processing, held in Paris in June 1959, which later came to be considered the first IFIP World Computer Congress (WCC); since then the WCC has been organized every two or three years. In the recent past, WCC was held in: Canada (2002), France (2004), Chile (2006), Italy (2008), Australia (2010), the Netherlands (2012), and Korea (2015).

WCC 2018

- The congress will combine content from industry and research, providing a place for integrating these two sectors as well as offering an opportunity to showcase and discover innovative ideas
- The content will range from the latest international research, to leading commercial and industry-focused advancements
- WCC will provide a unique opportunity to share with and listen to world-renowned experts in research and industry
- An important part of WCC will be keynote talks, given by world-class researchers and leading IT practitioners (we aim at inviting two Turing Award holders)
- The content of WCC will be provided as: keynote talks, regular presentations, tutorials, panels, workshops, student contest, PhD forum, and talks popularizing computer science technologies
